Core Structure:

The Concordia MBA consists of:

- 8 core modules
- 5 elective modules

Duration:

- minimum: 15 months
- maximum: 60 months

Intakes:

Each module starts every 4 weeks.

Assessment:

Assessment comprises a mix of:

- individual or group presentations
- trailing assignments
- case studies

Support & Delivery:

- online tutorials & library resources
- pre-recorded case study CDs
- Delivery will consist of:
 - o Pre-seminar preparation
 - o Seminar sessions
 - o Post seminar activities

Fee Structure:

The total fees for the program is RM32,000.

- Initial payment: RM6,000 followed by 13 monthly instalments of RM2,000

The fees cover registration and examination fees, e-course materials and online facilities including e-library, webcasts, e-languages, e-texts, etc.

Admission Requirements:

- A recognised Bachelors degree with a GPA of at least 2.70
- TOEFL score of 213 (computer) or 550 (paper). This is waived for undergraduate degrees conducted in English.
- Resume
- Two letters or recommendation

Application Procedure:

- Fully completed application form
- Original certificates & transcripts for verification & 2 photocopies
- 2 letters of reference
- 2 passport-sized photographs
- 1 photocopy of Identity Card
- TOEFL score
- Initial payment of RM6,000 made payable to "NetAcademy Sdn. Bhd."

'In keeping with the purpose of a MBA, our curriculum is designed to provide the student with a broad spectrum of the business scene. 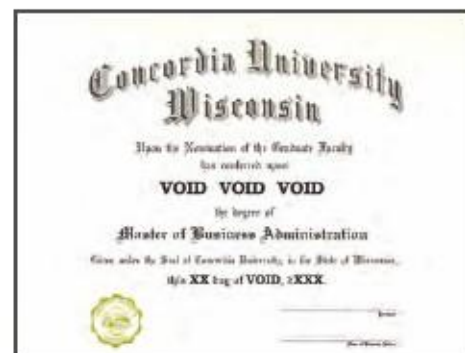
